Nomination Criteria

Do you know someone that fits into one of these categories?

The Constellation Award

A constellation is a grouping of stars forming a brilliant cluster.

(One Award Will Be Given)

This *community agency* supports, promotes, and contributes to families, children, and those who work in the field of Early Childhood.

Examples include: advocacy, financial resources, support and materials, training and education, and/or research.

The Shooting Star Award

A shooting star is a bright light in the atmosphere.

(Three Awards Will Be Given)

These *teachers* are nurturing, creative, and dedicated to families, children and other professionals in the field.

Examples include: provides loving and consistent care, able to touch lives through art, song, dance, and pretend play, has fresh ideas, enthusiasm, is energetic and continually learns new techniques.

Super Nova Award

A super nova is a brilliant explosion of a star flaring up to many times its original brightness.

(Three Awards Will Be Given)

These *Administrators* are resourceful, promote positive interactions and teamwork, and are stellar role models for their staff.

Examples include: advocates for families and children, supports, encourages, and mentors staff, provides extra resources and supports to families, keeps up-to-date on research and trends, creates solutions, is dependable, and a role model for others.

The Zenith Award

A zenith is the highest point or peak in the sky directly overhead.

(One Award Will Be Given)

This *individual* goes above and beyond in their contributions to the Early Childhood Community.

Examples include: advocates for families and children at a statewide or national level, has a caring nature and is always giving of themselves in both time and energy, shares knowledge with others through presentations, research and/or publications, and is a trailblazer with creative new ideas.

The Celestial Award

Celestial refers to heaven like beings who possess qualities similar to those of angels.

(Two Awards will be given)

These *supporting staff members* are an important part of the daily operations of a center.

Examples include: office staff, janitorial staff, kitchen staff, and volunteers.

The Parent's Choice Award

(Three Awards will be given)

These *ECE Professionals* have earned a place in the hearts of a parent for their dedication to the field, for their hard-work in their centers, and for the impact they have had on the lives of children. Parents may nominate any teacher, administrator, or support staff for this award.

Please Write a Narrative About the Nominee

To help the Awards Committee select the best person for each award, please include a narrative (or story) about the person or agency being nominated.

Your narrative must be typed and include:

- **A minimum of 100 words, but no more than 300.** (Past 300 words will not be read.)
- A description of the nominee's role or job (i.e. child's caregiver, parent, director.)
- Examples to show why they are being nominated. Examples might include stories about their work with children, parents, or caregivers—ways the person goes above and beyond the call of duty to make a difference for children and families and supports the field of Early Care and Education.

For your application to be considered, submit your narrative along with a completed Nomination Application Form.
